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#### INDEPENDENT AUDITOR'S REVIEW REPORT ON REVIEW OF INTERIM FINANCIAL RESULTS

#### TO THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF SOUTHERN PETROCHEMICAL INDUSTRIES CORPORATION LIMITED

- 1. We have reviewed the accompanying Statement of Standalone Unaudited Financial Results of SOUTHERN PETROCHEMICAL INDUSTRIES CORPORATION LIMITED ("the Company") for the Quarter ended June 30, 2016 ("the Statement"), being submitted by the Company pursuant to the requirement of Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015. This Statement which is the responsibility of the Company's Management and approved by the Board of Directors, has been prepared in accordance with the recognition and measurement principles laid down in Accounting Standard for Interim Financial Reporting (AS 25), prescribed under Section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013 read with relevant rules issued thereunder and other accounting principles generally accepted in India. Our responsibility is to issue a report on the Statement based on our review.
- 2. We conducted our review of the Statement in accordance with the Standard on Review Engagements (SRE) 2410'Review of Interim Financial Information Performed by the Independent Auditor of the Entity', issued by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India. This Standard requires that we plan and perform the review to obtain moderate assurance as to whether the Statement is free of material misstatement. A review is limited primarily to inquiries of Company personnel and analytical procedures applied to financial data and thus provides less assurance than an audit. We have not performed an audit and, accordingly, we do not express an audit opinion.
- 3. Based on our review conducted as stated above, nothing has come to our attention that causes us to believe that the accompanying Statement, prepared in accordance with the aforesaid Accounting Standards and other accounting principles generally accepted in India, has not disclosed the information required to be disclosed in terms of Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, including the manner in which it is to be disclosed, or that it contains any material misstatement.
- 4. We draw attention to Note No. 2 of the Statement regarding computation of subsidy based on the provisional Retention Price (RP) in line with the Government's policy, as the final retention price has not been announced by the Department of Fertilizers. The necessary adjustments, if any, and its consequential impact will be assessed when the final retention price is notified. Our report is not qualified in respect of this matter.

#### Notes:

- 1. The above financial results were reviewed and recommended by the Audit Committee and approved by the Board of Directors at their meetings held on 1<sup>sst</sup> August 2016.
- 2. Subsidy, for the period April to June 2016, of Rs.17005.05 lacs has been accounted based on the provisional Retention Price (RP) computed in line with the Government's policy, as the final retention price has not been announced by the Department of Fertilizers. The necessary adjustments, if any, and its consequential impact will be assessed when the final retention price is notified.
- 3. Total Income from Operations (net) includes Rs.2544.08 lacs being the primary and secondary freight subsidy accrued for the financial years 2010-11 to 2015-16 based on the revised road freight rates that were effective retrospectively from April 1, 2008 as per the Circulars issued by the Department of Fertilizers on June 17, 2016.
- 4. There is no provision for tax in view of the brought forward losses / unabsorbed depreciation relating to earlier years available for set off while computing income both under the provisions of Sec 115-JB and those other than Sec 115-JB of the Income Tax Act, 1961.
- 5. During the quarter, the Ammonia and urea plants, which were shut down for annual maintenance, with increased scope for improved sustainability, were in operation for 47 days, as against 58 days in the previous year's corresponding quarter, when plants were shut down due to policy issue. Hence the results for the current quarter is not exactly comparable with the corresponding quarter of the previous year.
- 6. Previous period's figures have been regrouped/recast, wherever necessary, to conform to the classification on the current year/period's classification.
- 7. Figures for the quarter ended 31 March 2016 represent the difference between the audited figures in respect of the full financial year ended 2016 and the published figures of nine months ended 31 December 2015, as regrouped.
